10. PARTICIPATION

National Teams may consist of:

Team Manager. Team Manager Assistant. One junior competitor and maximum 3 senior competitors in class F2A. One junior competitor and maximum 3 senior competitors in class F2B. One junior team and maximum 3 senior teams in class F2C. One junior competitor and maximum 3 senior competitors in class F2D. F2D mechanics. Supporters.

<u>**Remember**</u>! There will be a Lottery in which 3 competitors from each class will be drawn from a barrel to win AUD\$1000 each. (World Champs competitors only)

Direct qualification

The reigning World Champion has the right (subject to the approval of their NAC / National Airsports Control) to participate in the next World Championships in that category regardless of whether they qualify for the national team or not. If they are not a member of the national team, their score will not be considered in the team results. According to B.3.5 and B.3.4 SC ABR 2013

Licensing

Each competitor, team manager and assistant team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License, valid for 2016, issued by their NAC and be recorded on the FAI Database.

11. CLASSIFICATIONS AND AWARDS

There will be two independent individual and team classifications. Winners will be awarded with FAI medals and diplomas and the Organisers prizes.

20. MODELS PROCESSING

FAI Specification Certificate

Each competitor must present a valid FAI SPECIFICATION CERTIFICATE for his model/s/ from his NAC, according to FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling, Volume ABR 2015 Edition.

Important note

Model aircraft not properly processed by NAC, must be processed by the organiser at a cost of \$15AUD for each model.

21. NATIONAL FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Team manager duties

The Team Manager, or any other team member in his place, is kindly requested to bring two flags approximately 1 m x 1.5 m and a CD or USB containing the national anthem.

Collection and return

Flags and CD/USB will be collected during the team's registration, and returned after the closing ceremony.
